Wallhanging

Materials for the Wallhanging

One fat-eighth *EACH* of (19) assorted prints:

7891-38, 7891-44, 7891-66, 7892-44, 7892-66,
7892-77, 7893-44, 7893-77, 7894-44, 7894-66,
7895-38, 7895-44, 7895-77, 7896-38, 7896-44,
7896-66, 7897-38, 7897-44, 7897-66

$\frac{2}{3}$ yard	Printed Panel	7890P-44
$\frac{3}{4}$ yard	Red Diamonds	7893-88
	<i>(includes binding)</i>	
(1) fat-eighth	Red Stars	7894-88
$1\frac{3}{4}$ yards	Green Medallions	7891-66
	<i>(for quilt backing)</i>	

All supplies necessary for your preferred method of appliqué including thread to match red stars fabric.

Cutting Instructions for the Wallhanging

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

From *EACH* of the (19) assorted prints, cut:

(1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" strip.

From the (19) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, cut a total of:

(24) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (five of these should be cream).

(2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " pieces.

(2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces.

(2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{3}{4}$ " pieces.

From the printed panel, cut:

(1) piece 23" wide x 39" high with the printed motifs centered in the cut piece in both directions.

From the red diamonds, cut:

(9) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " strips. Reserve (4) strips for the inner border and (5) strips for the binding.

Reserve red stars fabric for appliqué motifs.

Appliqué

- As necessary for your preferred method of appliqué, prepare a template for the star motif. Please note that the paper pattern provided is full size and does not include seam allowance.
- Again as necessary for your chosen method of appliqué, prepare (5) star motifs using the red stars fabric. Below is a guide showing how to get all (5) stars from the fat-eighth.
- Using the method of your choice, appliqué a red star motif



to the front of a cream $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " cream square, with the star centered on the square in both directions. Repeat to make a total of (5) units.

1. Trim (2) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " red diamonds strips to 39". Stitch these strips to

Sewing Instructions for the Wallhanging

All seams are sewn using 1/4" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.

the left and right sides of the trimmed panel. Trim (2) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " red diamonds strips to $26\frac{1}{2}$ ". Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the trimmed panel.

2. Stitch together, side by side, (3) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, (1) appliqué star

block, and (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " piece, with the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " piece in the center as shown. The pieced border should measure $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ ". Sew this pieced border to the top of the panel unit from step 1, noting orientation.

3. Repeat the procedure from step 2, adjusting the placement of



the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " piece and the star block as shown in the diagram below, to make a second $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ " pieced border. Stitch this border to the bottom of the panel unit, again noting orientation.

4. Stitch together, end to end,



(7) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, (1) appliqué star block, (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{3}{4}$ " piece, and (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " piece, to yield a $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " pieced border. Place the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{3}{4}$ " piece above the star block. Place the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " piece at the bottom of the row. Stitch this border to the left side of the wallhanging.



5. Stitch together, end to end, (6) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, (2) appliqué star blocks, (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{3}{4}$ " piece, and (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " piece, to yield a $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " pieced border. Place the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " piece at the top of the row. Place the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{3}{4}$ " piece above the lower star block. Stitch this border to the right-hand side of the wallhanging.

6. Layer the completed wallhanging top with batting and backing and quilt as desired.

7. Bind the finished wallhanging using the remaining $2\frac{1}{4}$ " red diamonds strips.

One fat-quarter **EACH** of (20) assorted prints:

Cutting Instructions for the Quilt

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

From EACH of the (3) star prints, 7894-44, 7894-66, and 7894-88, cut:

(3) 2" x 21" strips. Recut into (8) 2" x 5 1/2" pieces.

From EACH of the (17) remaining assorted prints, cut:

(2) 5 1/2" x 21" strips. Recut into (3) 5 1/2" x 9 1/2" pieces.

From the printed panel, cut:

(12) pieces 5 1/2" wide x 9 1/2" high with the printed motifs, numbered 1-12, centered in both directions in each cut piece.

From the red diamonds, cut:

(1) 5 1/2" x 42" strips. Recut into (3) 5 1/2" x 9 1/2" pieces.

(7) 2 1/4" x 42" strips for the binding.

Sewing Instructions for the Quilt

Please note, the quilt is assembled in vertical columns, not horizontal rows. Refer to the row diagrams below for fabric placement, or use any arrangement you find pleasing. All seams are sewn using 1/4" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.

1. Stitch 2" x 5 1/2" star print pieces to each short end of a 5 1/2" x 9 1/2" printed panel motif piece. Repeat to make a total of (12) units.
2. Referring to the diagram below, stitch together (6) 5 1/2" x 9 1/2" assorted print pieces and the first day of Christmas unit from the printed panel to yield a 5 1/2" x 66 1/2" column for Column One. Again referring to the diagram below for fabric placement, stitch together (6) 5 1/2" x 9 1/2" assorted print pieces and the second and third days of Christmas units from the printed panel, to yield a 5 1/2" x 78" column for Column Two. To make the unit shown, trim the top and bottom pieces to yield a 66 1/2" long column. Using the diagrams below as guides, repeat the procedures from steps 1 and 2 to make a total of (11) column rows, using the number of pieces shown for each column and trimming as necessary to make each column 66 1/2" long.



3. Stitch the columns together, side by side, to complete the quilt top.
4. Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind the finished quilt using the 2 1/4" red diamonds strips.
