

BUTTON TREE LANE

Finished Quilt Size: 70" x 75½"

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Materials

1 fat quarter *EACH* of eighteen fabrics:

	8043-11, 8043-22, 8043-44, 8044-11, 8044-44, 8044-66, 8045-22, 8045-66, 8045-88, 8046-55, 8046-66, 8046-77, 8047-11, 8047-44, 8047-55, 8048-38, 8048-44, 8048-77	
1/3 yard	Printed Panel <i>(one full tree motif)</i>	8042-11
1 3/8 yards	Blue Novelty	8043-11
7/8 yard	Plum Buttonholes	8047-55
5/8 yard	Dark Brown Buttons	8048-38
5/8 yard	Dark Blue Buttons <i>(for binding)</i>	8048-77
4 5/8 yards	Blue Novelty <i>(for quilt backing/two horizontal panels)</i>	8043-11

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

From *EACH* of the eighteen fat quarters, cut:

- (1) 6" strip. Recut into (3) 6" x 6" squares.
- (1) 4" strip. Recut into (3) 4" x 6" pieces.
- (1) 3 1/4" strip. Recut into (6) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" squares.
- (1) 2 1/2" strip. Recut into (6) 2 1/2" x 3 1/4" pieces.

There will be extra patches of each size.

From the printed panel cut:

- (1) piece, 11 1/2" wide x 17" high, with a printed tree motif centered in the cut piece in both directions.

From the blue novelty, cut:

- (7) 6" strips for the middle border.

From the plum buttonholes, cut:

- (8) 3 1/4" strips for the outer border.

From the dark brown buttons, cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" strips for the inner border.


From the dark blue buttons, cut:

- (8) 2 1/4" strips for the binding.


Sewing Instructions

All seams are sewn using 1/4" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.

1. To make (1) Block A, stitch together (2) 2 1/2" x 3 1/4" pieces, side by side. Sew this unit to a long side of a 4" x 6" piece to complete (1) Block A, measuring 6" x 6", from raw edge to raw edge, in both directions. Repeat to make a total of (42) Block A.



2. To make (1) Block B, referring to the diagram at the top of the next page, arrange (4) 3 1/4" squares into (2) rows with (2) squares in each row. Sew the squares into rows and sew the rows together to complete (1) Block B, measuring 6" x 6", from raw edge to raw edge, in both directions. Repeat to make a total of (7) Block B.



3. Referring to the line drawing on page 2 and the quilt pictured on the cover, arrange the (42) Block A, (7) Block B, (35) 6" squares, and (1) printed tree motif as shown, noting orientation of each Block A and the printed tree motif.

4. For quilt rows 1-5, 9, and 10, stitch the (9) units into rows. Stitch together rows 1-5 to complete the upper portion of the quilt top. Stitch together rows 9 and 10 to complete the lower portion of the quilt.

5. To assemble the center section of the quilt, stitch (5) units together, side by side, for each of rows 6-8. Sew these rows together to complete the left-hand unit of the center section of the quilt. Stitch the assembled rows to the left-hand side of the printed tree motif piece, noting orientation of both units. Arrange the remaining blocks and 6" squares into (3) rows with (2) units in each row. Stitch the units into rows and sew the rows together to complete the right-hand unit of the center section of the quilt. Sew this unit to the right-hand side of the printed tree motif, noting orientation of both units, to complete the center section of the quilt top.

6. To complete the quilt top, stitch the upper and lower portions of the quilt top to opposite long sides of the center section of the quilt top, noting orientation of all units.

7. Trim the selvages from the 2 1/2" brown buttons strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, to make a long 2 1/2" strip. From this long strip, cut (2) 55 1/2" and (2) 54" lengths (*if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top*). Stitch the **longer** lengths to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew the **shorter** lengths to the top and bottom.










8. Trim the selvages from the 6" blue novelty strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, to make a long 6" strip. From this long strip, cut (2) 65" and (2) 59 1/2" lengths (*if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top*). Stitch the **shorter** lengths to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew the **longer** lengths to the top and bottom.

9. Trim the selvages from the 3 1/4" plum tonal strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, to make a long 3 1/4" strip. From this long strip, cut (4) 70 1/2" lengths (*if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top*). Stitch (2) lengths to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew (2) lengths to the top and bottom.

10. Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind the finished quilt using the 2 1/4" dark blue buttons strips.


BUTTON TREE LANE
